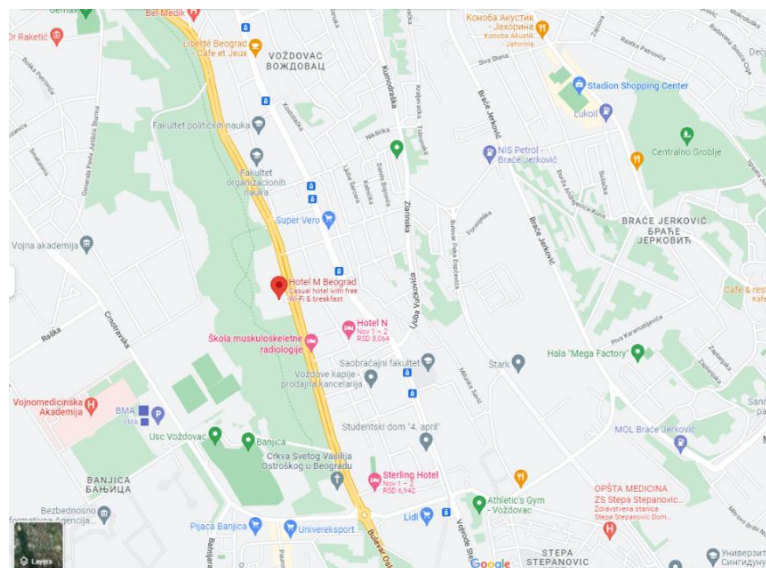
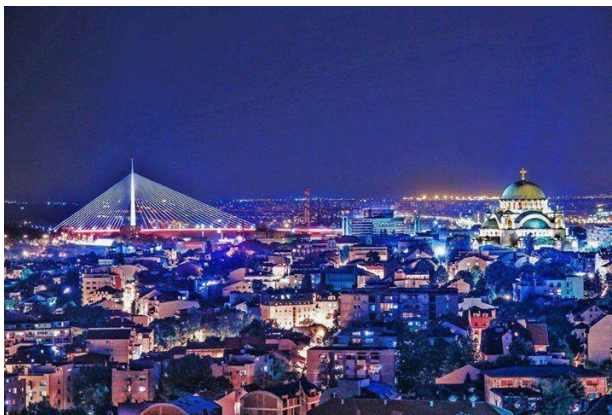

Alternatively, there are two public transport options to city centre, the A1 mini-bus which takes 30 minutes, or you can take bus line 72 from Belgrade airport to Zeleni Venac Square, which takes 35 minutes. To reach the Hotel M, you should look for Bus lines 47 or 48.

CONFERENCE LANGUAGE is English.

MONEY CURRENCY: main currency in Republic of Serbia is Serbian dinar. You can exchange money at exchange offices (in Serbian: MENJACNICA). There are exchange offices at the airport, just prior to exit. There are numerous exchange offices in the city. Both credit and debit cards are now widely accepted in Belgrade in most restaurants and shops (the sign is visible on the entrance door). The most commonly accepted cards are Visa, Visa Electron, Master and Maestro. Diners and American Express are less prevalent. Cards are less frequently used in bakeries, fast food outlets and tobacco stores, and never in farmers' markets so it's good to have some cash handy, if shopping at these. ATMs are numerous in Belgrade. Charging a commission for retrieving cash at bank's ATMs is up to the Bank, your own bank may impose additional expenses. Check before you leave.

The rate EUR to RSD on date 24.09.2022. is 1 EUR = 117 RSD
